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**Agenda for this meeting and subsequent resolution passed was taken up as follows:**

**1. Emergency medicines need to be given during the period of long journey of faculty/staff members provided if they ask for a specific medicine(s). They can be given only for the period of journey.**

The Convener informed that Pharmacy expenses of IIT Guwahati Hospital have been increasing day by day. He explained that medicines cannot be prescribed by anticipating an illness. Therefore, medicines cannot be given in long journey.

**R/MUG/01/2021/1:** The members resolved that anticipating an illness doctors cannot give way medicines. Therefore, medicines cannot given be for before travel on long journey.

**2. Token system with the help of indicator module need to be implemented while visiting a doctor.**

The Convener informed that an Electronic Token Display system already exists but has been suspended due to Covid-19 precautionary measures.

**R/MUG/01/2021/2:** The members resolved that the Electronic Token Display system will be *revoked* with the improvement of Covid-19 situation.

**3. Mechanism related to any special treatment in any specialty hospital of the country in case of critical illness as well as on emergency and contact procedure to start the treatment in the hospitals.**

The Convener intimated that a patient who is suffering from critical illness generally advised Institute Medical Board for outside state referral. IIT Guwahati Hospital can help the patient or his/her relative by offering medical suggestion however it very hard pin-point to suggest a particular hospital for treatment.

**R/MUG/01/2021/3:** No resolution was taken on this issue.

**4. The introduction of the appointment booking system for which currently the system of medical record book is used.**

The General Secretary, Welfare Board raised this issue. The Convener intimated that the IIT Guwahati Hospital maintains health records through medical record books and there are some technical issues like appointment timings of doctors, emergency duties and internet adaptability by patient in-order to introduce online appointment booking system.

**R/MUG/01/2021/4:** The members resolved that Students' Web Committee will give a *presentation* of online appointment booking system. The members suggested the proposed portal should not however hamper the existing system of the hospital.

*The following issues were raised with the permission of the chair. The issues and subsequent resolutions passed in the meeting are as follows:*

**5. The mobile for Hospital Ambulance Driver, Hospital Registration Counter and Medical Officer On-Duty who is allotted emergency duty.**

**R/MUG/01/2021/5:** The members resolved that separate mobiles (basic mobiles only) should be allotted to Ambulance Driver, Registration Counter and Medical Officer On-Duty (emergency duty).

**6. Empanelment of some new hospitals like the Pratiksha Hospital, the ASG Eye Hospital and the Akanksha Hospital all located in Guwahati under IIT Guwahati.**

**R/MUG/01/2021/6:** The members resolved that the diagnostic tests rates of these hospitals should be analysed for comparison with some of the already empanelled hospitals of the Institute before starting the process of empanelment.

**7. Fitness certificate for students applying for jobs abroad and reimbursement of medical expenses from IIT Guwahati for obtaining the fitness certificate.**

This issue was raised by the students' representative in the meeting. The doctors present in the meeting suggested that medical reimbursement for obtaining jobs is not permissible. They suggested that the medical reimbursement is possible for expenses incurred for referral for treatment in case of person suffering from some of kind ailment or disease.

**R/MUG/01/2021/6:** The members resolved that although doctors of IIT Guwahati can give recommendation for fitness test for job application can be given however no medical reimbursement will be allowed in this case.
